CRAMERTON POLICE RELOCATES OPERATIONS DURING HISTORIC TOWN HALL RENOVATION

The Cramerton Police Department will relocate its operations during the month of October. The temporary move for the agency is due to the upcoming renovation of the historic Cramerton Town Hall and Police Department. The renovation will displace both the police department and general government services for approximately nine months. Both divisions of Town Government should return to the North Main Street location in August, 2011. General government offices will relocate to the Cramerton Community Center (1 Julian Street, Cramerton) sometime in November.

Due to an agreement between the Cramerton Police Department and the owners and management of the Hampton Meadows Apartments the Cramerton Police Department will be relocated to the apartment complex. "The temporary move will serve both parties well," according to Cramerton Police Chief Greg Ratchford. "The location will give the police department the room it needs to conduct administrative operations for the time we are displaced and the constant police presence at the apartment complex will curb some of the unwanted behavior that is taking place from time to time," Ratchford said.

The temporary location is not intended to be a public facility according to Ratchford. The public will still need to meet with officers and administrative staff at the Cramerton Town Hall location.
